[Primary Text: Genesis 1:1]

PRAY

Pause. Acknowledge that you are about to open God's word.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to illuminate His word.

WARM-UP (10 mins)

Prepare our minds to receive God's word.

- LG Foundations (on reverse page): What did you learn from the foundations course for last week (topic: the quiet time)?
- How has your walk with the Lord been this week?
- When reflecting on the message this past Sunday, what most resonated with you?

ILLUMINATE (40 mins)

Open your Bibles to the primary text. If you do not have a Bible, your leader can provide one.

- The Bible begins with one very extraordinary, supernatural statement, "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." In light of what we know about God, why did God create the heavens and the earth?
- [In the beginning, God] What can we gather from this phrase? Was God himself a created being? How does God himself answers this question in Exodus 3:14?
- In the last century, our culture has been dominated by the philosophy of naturalism. What is naturalism? How does God fit or not fit in the philosophy of naturalism?
- [God created the heavens and the earth] God created the heavens in general and he created the earth in particular. What do we learn from this contrast?
- Romans 8:19-20 says that creation itself declares something about God. What does creation display? Was Jesus present during the creation process?
- Can Salvation be gained through the observation and acknowledgement of God's creation? Why or why not?
- After scratching the surface of Genesis 1:1, what do you take away from this text?

PRAY

Use this time to pray specifically. What does tonight's conversation lead you to pray for?
