[Primary Text: Genesis 24]

PRAY

Pause. Acknowledge that you are about to open God's word.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to illuminate His word.

WARM-UP (10 mins)

Prepare our minds to receive God's word.

- LG Foundations (on back page): What did you learn from the foundations course for last week (topic: "Personal Testimony")?
- When reflecting on the message this past Sunday, what most resonated with you?

ILLUMINATE (40 mins)

Open your Bibles to the primary text. If you do not have a Bible, your leader can provide one.

- Let's read through chapter 24 to refresh our memories.
- Why did Abraham request that his servant put his hand under his thigh?
- Abraham tells his servant that God would send an angel to go before him. We know that God often works in supernatural ways. How does the Bible support that the Lord goes before us?
- Why was Abraham looking outside of Canaan for a bride for his son Isaac? What context do we need to understand this decision?
- What kind of woman was the servant looking for? How did he go about determining that Rebekah was the one?
- What did the servant go about requesting that Rebekah leave her family and go to a foreign land? How did this conversation go?
- When you reflect back on your life? Do you think God may have been guiding you along the way? Why or why not? If God's guidance feels absent from your life, even if for a season, would you say that your pursuit of God was strong or lacking?
- Which figure in this biblical account do you most relate to? Why?

PRAY

Use this time to pray specifically. What does tonight's conversation lead you to pray for?
