- Based on the opening verses of this chapter, how would you describe Jesus to someone else? Could you put verses 1-4 in your own words? Who is willing to try?
- The sermon introduction video gave us a tip; look up Old Testament quotations. Are there any we need to look up tonight to help us understand and navigate this text?
- How does Hebrews chapter 1 explain the primary purpose of angels? Does this change your view of angels at all?
- What is the value of knowing Christ's position among the angels? Why do you think the author spend time on this?
- If you could us one word, what do you think this chapter would say: Jesus is _____.
