PRAY

Pause. Acknowledge that you are about to open God's word.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to illuminate His word.

WARM-UP (10 mins)

Prepare our minds to receive God's word.

- LG Foundations (on back page): What did you learn from our last foundations training (topic: "Follow-Up")?
- When reflecting on the message this past Sunday, what most resonated with you?

ILLUMINATE (40 mins)

Open your Bibles to the primary text. If you do not have a Bible, your leader can provide one.

- Let's read together Hebrews chapter 2 to remind us of the content.
- Verse 1 says, "we must pay closer attention to what we have heard lest we drift away from it." What is "it" in this verse?
- Consider the ocean. How does drifting happen? Can drifting cause you to lose your life? How do we fight
- The Mosaic law or old covenant came with swift penalty if not obeyed. Verse 3 says, "how shall we ESCAPE if we neglect such a great salvation?" What do you think the author is saying to us here?
- Why did Jesus have to become human and why did Jesus have to die? Verses 14-18 help us with this.
- Verse 14 says that Jesus destroyed the power of death through his own death. Have you ever considered this idea? How exactly did Jesus accomplish this?
- What about chapter 2 brings you joy, peace, comfort?
- As a Christian, you must always be prepared to share the gospel. Who is willing to share the gospel with the group tonight?

PRAY

Use this time to pray specifically. What does tonight's conversation lead you to pray for?
