2. If you could capture it in one word, how would you describe God's response to Job? Why?
3. Why do you think God responded to Job and his friends in this way?
4. As this text paints a picture of God, is there any particular verse or phrase in this portion of scripture that creates in you awe and wonder of who God is?
5. How does Job respond to the Lord's rebuke (42:1-6)?
6. What is the behemoth and what is the leviathan? Why do you think the Lord introduced these two beings?
7. Who would be willing to give us a 2-minute recap of the book of Job up to this point? If no one, let's piece the story together as a group.
8. Someone says to you, "the book of Job is nothing but a mythical piece of literature." How might you respond?
