3/3 - Revelation 19-20 (Armageddon)

LOVE

A new commandment I give to you, that you love *one another*... (John 13:34)

- *Internal*: How was your week...anything new?! How was your walk with the Lord this week?
- *External*: Is there any individual or family who is struggling or needs encouragement from us?

TRUTH

Let the word of God dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing *one another*... (Col. 3:16)

1. When you reflect on the message from Sunday, what most resonated with you?
[Dialogue]
2. Let's read the 2 chapters listed above as we continue to make our way through Revelation. What were the four shouts of "Hallelujah" for in chapter 19?
The Fall of Babylon and the declaration in found in chapter 18:20, and it also anticipates the second coming of Jesus unfolding in the following passages.
3. When you read about the rider on the white horse, how does it make you feel given all that we have read?
[Dialogue]
4. How is Jesus described here? Is this how you expected His return to be?
 - Called Faithful and True
 - Eyes like a flame of fire
 - Head covered in diadems (Jewels)
 - A name written that no one knows
 - Clothed in a robe dipped in blood
 - Named/Called the Word of God
5. Discuss the differences between Jesus' first and second coming?
[Example: Came riding on a Horse vs. Donkey]
6. How does the cross show us that Jesus believed in the reality of Hell?
[Example: The work of Christ on the cross makes a way for us to be rescued from the reality of Hell]
7. Does chapter 20 soften the reality of Hell? Should we soften it when speaking to others? How should we navigate this reality when speaking with believers and non-believers?
[Dialogue]
8. In what ways are the millennial reign be like the garden of Eden prior to the fall?
[Example: We will be beginning our return to the way it was supposed to be, God's original design, ruling and reigning in harmony with the Father.]
9. Any closing thoughts concerning these chapters?
[Dialogue]

GREAT COMMISSION

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations... (Matt. 28:19-20)

- Did you disciple your family well this week? Is Jesus the reason for your hope in your daily activity?

CONFESSION/PRAYER/REPENTANCE

But exhort *one another* every day, as long as it is called "today,"... (Heb. 3:12-14)

- Confession is agreeing with God about our sin according to the Scriptures. Is there anything you want to confess before the group? [*apathy, idolatry, selfishness, jealousy, anger, envy*]
- Let's pray, asking God to help us apply His word to our lives, putting to death sinful desires.
