1. _____ = to dip or immerse
(Specific Action)

“Historians agree that the mode of baptism in the Early Church was by immersion. The believer was ‘buried’ in the water and brought up again as a picture of the death, burial and resurrection. Baptism by immersion pictures the believer’s identification with Christ in His death, burial and resurrection. It is the outward symbol of an inward experience... The believer has a new relationship to sin. He is ‘dead’ to sin, but ‘raised to walk in newness of life’ in Christ.” —Warren Wiersbe
