Barna: Only 5% of the U.S. population tithes.

Health Research Funding: Only 3-5% of Americans who give to their local church do so through regular tithing.

Health Research Funding: For Christian families making less than \$20k per year, 8% of them gave at least 10% in tithing. For families making a minimum of \$75k or more, the figure drops to just 1%.

Health Research Funding: People are more likely to practice tithing when they begin in their teens or early twenties.

Relevant: A 10% increase in giving from church goers would result in an additional \$165 billion in church funds.

Cleveland Clinic: The scientifically-proven benefits of giving include: lower blood pressure, increased self-esteem, less depression, lower stress levels, longer life, and greater happiness.
