What does this mean ?
> Inspiration has to do with Source All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training ir righteousness, that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work. —2 Timothy 3:16-17 ESV
> Inspiration has to do with Process knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. —2 Peter 1:20-21
 Illumination
This is the active and ongoing work of the Holy Spirit related to the Bible. The Holy Spirit must enable
people to <u>understand</u> and <u>embrace</u> the truth of Scripture.
