“I’d say a lot of people want liver,” says Nucatola. “And for that reason, most providers will do this case under ultrasound guidance so they’ll know where they’re putting their forceps. The kind of rate-limiting step of the procedure is the calvarium. Calvarium—the head—is basically the biggest part. . . .”
